

# Commandry Officers Jewels of Knight Templars.

## 1. Eminent Commander

- A. **Jewel**-Cross & Crown ( a passion cross surmounted by a crown)
- B. **Meaning**- Authority, Leadership, and the principle “In Hoc Signo Vinces” (By this sign we shall conquer).

## 2. Generalissimo

- A. **Jewel** -Square, surmounted by a Paschal lamb
- B. **Meaning**: Duty to plan guide and ensure purity of purpose. The lamb symbolizes innocence and sacrifice.

## 3. Captain General-

- A. **Jewel** Level, surmounted by a cock (Rooster)
- B. **Meaning** -Vigilance and equality: the Cock represents watchfulness and loyalty.

## 4. Prelate-

- A. **Jewel**-Cross (often the Latin or Passion Cross)
- B. **Meaning**:- Spiritual guidance and the moral light of Christianity

## 5. Senior Warden-

- A. **Jewel** -Hollow Square (open square) with a mailed fist grasping a sword of Justice
- B. **Meaning**: Duty of support and strength

## 6. Junior Warder-

- A. **Jewel**- Eagle with, wings expanded.
- B. **Meaning**: Courage, foresight, and protection

## 7. Treasurer

- A. **Jewel** - Crossed keys
- B. **Meaning**: Responsibility for the financial trust of the Commandry

## 8. Recorder-

- A. **Jewel**-Crossed Quills
- B. **Meaning**: record-keeping, diligence and communication

## 9. Standard Bearer-

- A. **Jewel**: Banner or crossed Banners
- B. **Meaning**: Defender of the order’s Honor and Traditions

**10. Sworder Bearer-**

**A. Jewel:** Crossed swords

**B. Meaning:** Duty to guard and protect the Standard of the Commandery

**11. Warder**

**A. Jewel:** Trumpet

**B. Meaning:** Duty to announce and maintain order.

**12. Sentinel (Guards)**

**A. Jewel:** Swords

**B. Meaning:** Duty of protection, vigilance, and security
